## **Special Skills Exam**

The Special Talent Exam for the Painting, Ceramics and Glass and Traditional Turkish Arts Departments of the faculty is held jointly for all departments. Exam papers are distributed by our faculty.

- In the exam, the candidates' knowledge of pattern, creative thinking and design are evaluated through the composition determined as the exam question.
- The exam is a single session exam and evaluated over 100 points.
- The jury completing the exam evaluation process, submits the exam papers to the Special Talent Exam Executive Committee with a official report. With the participation of at least two jury members, the committee opens the names of the candidates that were covered on the exam papers, and then the exam result lists are prepared according to their scores.
- The placement score of the candidates scoring 50 and above is determined according to the 2022-2023 Sakarya University International Student Admission Criteria.
- Candidates evaluated according to their placement score are placed in order of preference.

#### **Materials to Bring on Exam Day**

- 1. Pencil, HB, 2B, 3B etc.
- 2. Soft Eraser
- 3. Sharpener
- 4. Picture mat in 50x70 cm size
- 5. Original Official Identity Card (Birth Certificate, Driving Licence, Passport that has not expired, Temporary Protection Document, Resident Permission Document)

#### Rules to be obeyed during exam

- 1. No candidate will be allowed to take the exam if she/he does not bring the original identity document exemplified above.
- 2. Candidates must be present at the exam venue with the exam materials at least one hour before the commence of the exam.
- 3. Candidates arriving 30 minutes after the start of the exam will not be allowed to take the exam. Candidates cannot leave the exam hall before the first 40 minutes following the start of the exam.
- 4. Candidates must comply with the warnings of the examiners.
- 5. Candidates cannot take part in the exam with a mobile phone, walkie-talkie, pocket computer, FM microphone, voice recorder or transmitter, MP3 player, CD player, a watch with a function other than the time display, any kind of computer-enabled devices, weapons and the like etc.
- 6. Talking, sharing or exchanging erasers/pencils/sharpeners, changing places, smoking, using headphones, eating and drinking and engaging in negative actions or behaviours are prohibited during the exam.

7. Candidates who do not comply with the exam rules during the exam are taken out of exam

hall. Their ID cards and exam papers are kept by the examiners. In this case, the candidate loses

all his/her right as far as the exam is concerned.

8. The candidate's exam will be deemed invalid when all kinds of writings, signs, drawings, etc.

are available on the exam paper of the candidate other than what is required for the question

asked.

9. The relevant provisions of the SAU Education and Examination Regulation and Special

Skills Examination Directive are valid for matters not included in this booklet.

10. Officials are authorized and responsible for the implementation of the exam rules.
